



## **Saints Halftime Performance:** **Frequently Asked Questions**

After we receive your registration, you will be emailed a letter around September 21st, with many more details regarding the practice and game day procedures. Please note that we are not directly affiliated with the New Orleans Saints, so we cannot provide any exceptions regarding tickets, parking, etc.

### **GAME TICKETS:**

The New Orleans Saints recommend that you visit the Ticket Exchange which can be accessed through [www.neworleansaints.com](http://www.neworleansaints.com) or [www.ticketmaster.com](http://www.ticketmaster.com). Once the performers enter the Dome the day of the game, they will remain inside through the game. However, IF a parent wants their child to sit with them after the halftime show, that performer WILL NEED A TICKET TO HAVE A SEAT. Those who stay with our group through the game WILL NOT NEED A TICKET.

### **SUNDAY, OCTOBER 7<sup>TH</sup> REHEARSAL:**

Parents will *drop-off* performers at their assigned registration time, and return at the end of rehearsal to pick them up. We have staff and chaperones to run rehearsal. You will receive all Game Day Information, including check-in and check-out times, locations, and procedures before you leave. PLEASE make sure to read this paper carefully.

### **WHAT TO WEAR ON REHEARSAL DAY:**

- Black shorts or pants
- Tennis shoes
- White T-shirt

Please note that water and snacks will be provided during the day. You can bring a lunch, snacks & drinks (no soft drinks please) with you as well.

### **UNIFORMS:**

Game day uniforms & any props will be distributed to the girls on the day of the game.

## **GAME DAY PROCEDURES:**

Performers typically arrive to the Dome around 5 hours prior to kick-off on game day to begin rehearsal. Rehearsal lasts around 1-2 hours, after which the performers will be fed dinner and given time to change into their performance attire. Large televisions are set up in our holding area for the performers to view the game.

CHECK OUT: There are 3 options set up for check out:

1. A parent is attending game and will come to an assigned area INSIDE the Dome to get their child.
2. A parent is NOT attending the game and will come to an assigned area OUTSIDE of the Dome to get their child. Staff members will escort and wait with these performers.
3. Another family member, friend, or coach is attending the game. Parents can give permission for this person to check out their child.

## **IMPORTANT NOTES ABOUT GAME DAY:**

- ◆ **No outside food or drink is allowed into the Dome.**
- ◆ During the Halftime performance, you will not be able to move from your seats to photograph. Dome Security will enforce this.
- ◆ You may not bring video cameras into the Superdome. Unfortunately, we cannot offer a video of the performance.
- ◆ There is no re-entry with your game ticket. (The checkout procedure happens inside the Dome for this purpose.)
- ◆ Please carefully read the new NFL rules about bringing bags into the Superdome here: <http://www.nfl.com/qs/allclear/index.jsp>. You will receive more information about what type of bag your performer can bring on game day.
