This must come from the school counselor and have his/her signature. Your portfolio may also include additional letters of recommendation, newspaper clippings, and any additional information that may assist in the selection process.

Step 3: FINAL COMPETITION (Saturday, January 17, 2026)

More details will be sent closer to the event. Applicants will submit their portfolio to the check-in area. Applicants should wear a black leotard, skin color tights, & skin-tone footwear. All applicants will be taught a routine on the spot to perform for the judges. The scholarship winner will be announced during the final awards ceremony at the end of competition on Sunday.
